### **THE RIVALRY**

- Since 1954 the Saskatchewan Roughriders and B.C. Lions have clashed 167 times during regular season play.
- Roughriders have won 87 contests while B.C. has been victorious 76 times
- The Riders and Lions have also battled to a draw four times.
- The Roughriders and Lions met for the first time on August 30th, 1954...on that historic day the Roughriders shut out B.C. 17-0...it is the only time in history the Roughriders shut out the Leos in regular season play.
- The Roughriders swept the Lions in a season series in 2003 for the first time since 1992.
- The Lions last swept the Riders in 1999 and 1998...they also swept the Roughriders in 1995.

#### **2007**

- Saskatchewan and B.C. met three times in the regular season.
- The Lions beat the Riders in their first meeting at Mosaic Stadium 42-12.
- The two met up in B.C. a few weeks later when the Riders won 21-9.
- In their last meeting of the regular season at Mosaic Stadium, the Lions claimed a come from behind 37-34 win to take the season series.

#### **2006**

- Saskatchewan and B.C. met four times in the regular season.
- The Lions beat the Riders in the season opener 45-28 in B.C..
- The Roughriders returned the favour twice – once at home the following week with a 32-24 win and then back in B.C. in three weeks later when they claimed a 29-28 victory. In September the Riders captured the season series with a 23-20 OT win over the Lions at Mosaic Stadium.

#### **2005**

- Saskatchewan and B.C. met three times in the regular season.
- The Lions beat the Riders at Taylor Field 19-15.
- The Roughriders returned the favour twice at B.C., knocking off the Lions 28-19 and again 13-12 during the last game of the regular season.

#### **2004**

- Saskatchewan and B.C. met twice during the regular season last year with each team winning in their home park.
- The Riders beat the Lions at Taylor Field in week 3 by a 42-29 score. The Lions returned the favour in week 18 at B.C. Place beating the Riders 40-38.
- The Lions also beat the Roughriders in the Western Division Final by a score of 27-25.

#### **2003**

- The Riders and Lions met three times in 2003 with Saskatchewan winning every contest.
- The Riders knocked off the Lions at Taylor Field in week 2 by a 32-30 score. They once again used home field advantage in week 12 with a 28-2 victory. They also won at B.C. Place in week 18 by a score of 26-23.
